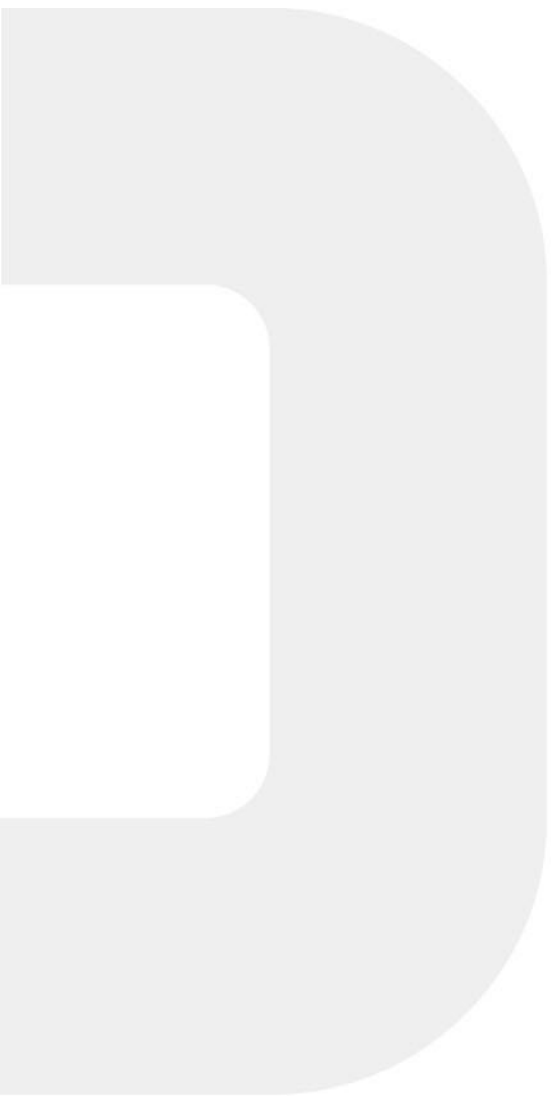
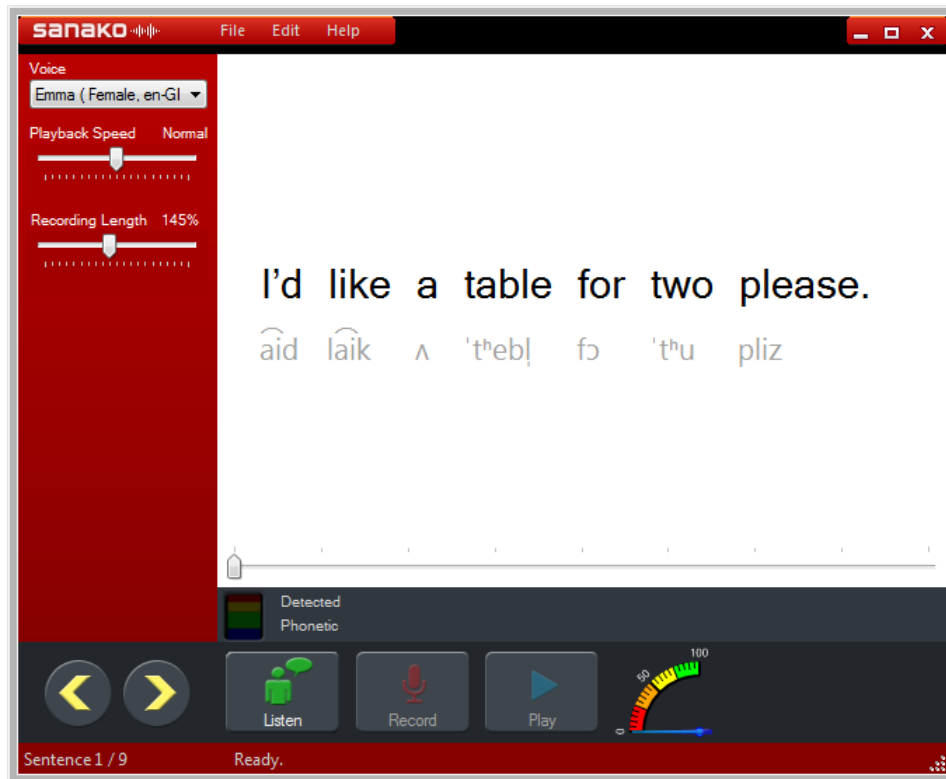

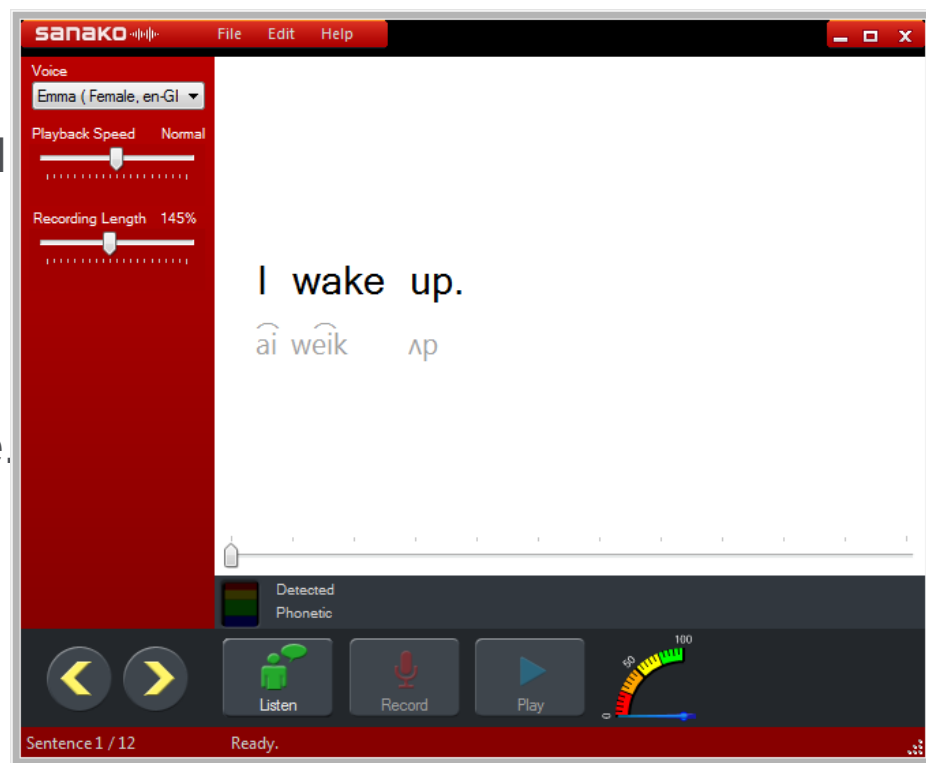
- Unlimited learning resources as any text material can be transformed into a live audio exercise

How to practice with Pronounce?

Pronounce automatically splits your text material into sentences.

- Select the **voice** that will read the model sentences.
- Adjust the **playback speed** of model audio. Lower speed may be used to facilitate understanding.
- Adjust how long your own **recording time** will be in comparison with the model sentence.
- Use the arrows to go to the **next / previous sentence**
- **Listen** to the current sentence
- **Record** yourself repeating the current sentence



Pronunciation analysis and feedback

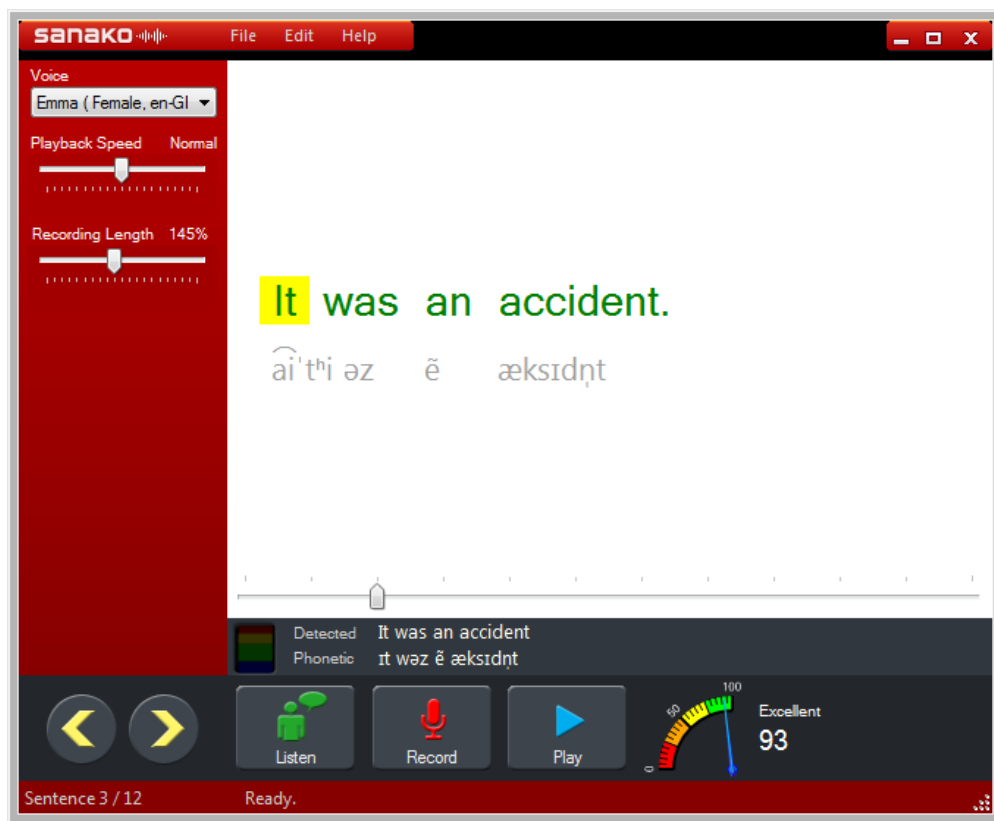
Whilst recording, the system is analyzing your speech. Once the recording is complete, Pronounce will automatically score your performance.

Green indicates that your pronunciation was correct.

Yellow highlight indicates your pronunciation could be improved.

Red color indicates your pronunciation was not recognized.
